Macaron Mix Up Game

Supplies needed: printer & card stock paper (or send to print shop), macaron storage boxes, boxes for macarons Optional: animal or doll friends, additional desserts like cupcakes or cookies with boxes

Instructions:

Cut out each of the order cards and place them in a stack next to the tray. Untwist the macarons and place them on a tray. Place any other treats you want to use on the tray with them. You an use the "Order 6" card to add your additional treats by drawing the items you use and the amount. Make sure all of the treats are mixed up on the tray. Set out the boxes for the treats. Place the stuffed animals around the room where the kids can see them. Once the game begins, have the kids deliver the treat boxes with the order cards to each animal.

Read Aloud:

"Mrs. Mouseling has some orders at her bakery that need to go out this afternoon. Her customers are all on their way, but when she went back to the kitchen to find her orders, she was in such a hurry that she knocked over the pastry cart and all of the orders got mixed up! Can you help Mrs. Mouseling fill the boxes with the correct pastries before her customers arrive? Let's get started!"

Additional ideas:

Give the kids a time limit to complete the order - If there are enough kids, you can divide them into teams and have a race to complete all of their orders
